## **Local Control and Accountability Plan Highlights**

A **draft of the 2019-2020 Local Control and Accountability Plan** (LCAP) was presented to the Board of Trustees on June 3rd. The LCAP plan has five major goals:

- 1. Achievement for all students in English Language Arts and Math
- 2. Develop a culture of professional growth for all teachers
- 3. Achievement in Science and the Next Generation Science Standards
- 4. Provide safe and comfortable learning environments that meet intellectual, social, emotional, and physical needs of all Orinda school communities
- 5. Provide all students with a 21st century educational experience

The LCAP plan details the programs and other actions that Orinda schools take to achieve these five goals. It also details the broad amount of teachers, parents, and others who were solicited for input, including the school climate survey to which more than 500 parents responded district-wide. A few of the highlights of this year's LCAP are:

- The work of our Teachers on Special Assignment (TOSAs: Literacy- Kim Burris, Math- Ashley Appel, Technology- Kevin Cutler, and STEAM- Katie Gardner)
- Counseling support for all elementary schools (supported by our Parents' Clubs!)
- The work of Literacy Intervention Specialists, Betsy Howe and Stephanie Sado.
- A focus on Social Emotional Learning and support: character education, teacher training, and service learning such as the Peace Kits for Ponderosa Project.

Feedback from the Board and other stakeholders is being integrated into the final version of the LCAP, which will be presented at the Board Meeting on June 10th.
