

It will ask for some of your personal information to determine what legislative district you're in. This will never be shared with anyone else.

Once you fill out the information, hit the blue Submit button- you're all done!

TO SUBMIT PUBLIC COMMENT...

Select "Participate" on the "Additional Meeting Details" section.

It will take you to the Meeting Participation page, where you'll need to fill in some basic information. Then you will select whether you wish to comment on a specific agenda item, or just make a general public comment.

Are you here for an agenda item or for public comment?

You may sign in for both. Select "Public Comment" for general comments not related to a bill or budget on the agenda.

Agenda Item Public Comment

You can choose one or multiple bills on the agenda.

Select item(s) from the drop down menu, your position (if any), who you are representing, and check the box if you wish to speak.

Then click "Add this item."



TO GIVE TESTIMONY BY PHONE...

Time is of the Essence

All testimony is being limited to 2 minutes. Prepare your remarks beforehand. Because of the virtual nature of the session, there's a chance that even if you sign up, you may not be called upon to give testimony due to time constraints.

Check the Agenda

At the bottom of every agenda, there are instructions for how to submit written testimony. Craft your statement, then send it to the listed email on the agenda as soon as possible. Here's an example from a Senate Education agenda.
