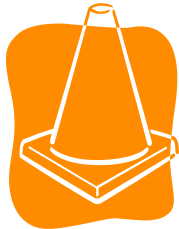

TAMC CONE ZONE REPORT

ROAD AND LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR April 19 – April 25

MONTEREY COUNTY – Here are the major scheduled road and lane closures for Monterey County from **Sunday, April 19 through Saturday, April 25**– **newest information is in red**. Please keep in mind that construction work is weather-dependent.

Highway 1: Handley Drive, Carmel – Route 183 (Castroville): April 20 - April 21

One moving lane closure will occur along northbound and southbound Highway 1 between Handley Drive and Route 183 (Merritt Street) for vegetation spraying from 8:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Highway 1: Molera Park Entr/Coast Road – Torre Canyon Bridge: April 20 – April 24

One-way traffic controls will be in place along northbound and southbound Highway 1 from the Molera Park Entrance/Coast Road to Torre Canyon Bridge for grinding and paving work from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday – Thursday; and 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday.

Highway 1: Carmel Valley Road – Molera Park Entr/Coast Road: April 20 – April 24

One-way traffic controls will be in place along northbound and southbound Highway 1 between Carmel Valley Road and Molera Park Entrance/Coast Road for grinding and paving work from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Route 68: Route 218 – York School Road: April 19 - 24

One nighttime lane closure will occur along eastbound Highway 68 between Route 218 (Canyon Del Rey Boulevard) and York School Road for utility work from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Route 68: Piedmont Avenue – State Route 1 (Pacific Grove to Monterey): April 20 - April 24

Daytime one-way traffic controls will be in place along eastbound and westbound Highway 68 between Piedmont Avenue and State Route 1 for drainage work along the highway from 7 am. to 5 p.m.



Route 68: Piedmont Avenue – State Route 1 (PG to Monterey): April 19 - April 24

One-way traffic controls will be in place along eastbound and westbound Highway 68 between Piedmont Avenue and State Route 1 for drainage work along the highway from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. in the evening, Sunday - Thursday.

Highway 101: Echo Valley Road – Dunbarton Road (South): April 22

One lane closure will occur along northbound Highway 101 between Echo Valley Road and Dunbarton Road (south) for drainage cleaning work along the highway from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Highway 101: Tustin Road – San Miguel Canyon Road: April 21

One lane closure will occur along southbound Highway 101 between Tustin Road and San Miguel Canyon Road for drainage cleaning work along the highway from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Highway 101: Boronda Road - San Benito County Line: April 25

A moving lane closure will occur along northbound and southbound Highway 101 between Boronda Road and the San Benito County Line for vegetation spraying from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Highway 101: Airport Blvd – Route 183: April 19 – April 24

One surface street lane closure will occur on Airport Blvd at Highway 101 for work on the bridge from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Highway 101: Airport Blvd – North Main Street: April 22 – April 23

A moving lane closure will occur along northbound and southbound Highway 101 between Airport Boulevard and Route 183 (North Main Street) for vegetation spraying from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Highway 101: Alta St/Old Stage Road – East Market Street: April 20 – April 24

One lane closure will occur along northbound and southbound Highway 101 between Alta Street/Old Stage Road and East Market Street for utility from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Highway 101: Little Bear Creek Bridge – Boronda Road, Salinas: Long-Term

Nighttime closures of the southbound on and off ramps of Highway 101 at Little Bear Creek Bridge and Boronda Road for paving work from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Crews will be working in the evenings Sunday – Thursday.

Highway 101: Layouts – First Street, King City: Long-Term Closure

There will be one lane closure along northbound and southbound Highway 101 from Layouts to First Street in King City for pavement work from 9:30 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.

Highway 101: Camp Roberts Rest Area: Long-Term Closure

There will be full closure of the northbound and southbound Camp Roberts Rest Area for electrical and emergency work.



Highway 101: Lockwood/San Lucas Road: April 20 – April 24

The on and off ramps on northbound & southbound Highway 101 at Lockwood/San Lucas Road will be closed for excavation work.

Highway 101: Lockwood/San Lucas – Paris Valley Road: Long-Term Closure

There will be one lane closure on northbound & southbound Highway 101 at Lockwood/San Lucas Road for excavation work.

Highway 101: Monterey Road – East Garrison, San Luis Obispo County: Long – Term Closure

One long-term alternating lane closure will occur along northbound and southbound Highway 101 in San Luis Obispo County between Monterey Road and East Garrison for miscellaneous road work from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Route 183: Rossi Street: April 20

One lane closure will occur along northbound Rossi Street at Highway 183 (Main Street) for electrical work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Route 183: Casentini Street: April 20

One lane closure will occur along southbound Casentini Street at Highway 183 for electrical work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Route 218: Harcourt Avenue – Hilby Avenue: April 20 – April 24

One lane closure will occur along eastbound State Route 218 (Canyon Del Rey Boulevard) between Harcourt Avenue and Hilby Avenue for utility work from 8:30 – 4:30 p.m.

Porter Drive, Pajaro: Salinas Road - San Juan Road: Now: May 1

PG&E crews will be replacing 900 feet of gas main pipelines on Porter Drive between Salinas Road and San Juan Road. Motorist should expect traffic delays.
