Card Design Theme: Jesus in the manger, Our Bread of Life

Christmas is a celebration of life. The very Word of God "became flesh and dwelt among us" (John 1:14). At the Christmas Mass, we sing songs full of hope and joy! We exchange gifts with those we love in remembrance of God giving us the gift of Himself in the person of Jesus. Children do act and representations of the birth of Jesus. We have nativities set up with angels, Mary, Joseph, humble shepherds, and wise travelers all gathered around this infant God lying in a manger.

Perhaps, you want to know that a manger is a feeding trough. It comes from the Latin word "manducare" meaning "to eat." And the town where this particular manger was located was Bethlehem, which means "House of Bread." Jesus later refers to himself by saying, "I am the bread of life" (John 6:35) and "I am the bread that came down from heaven" (John 6:41).

Children who are in grades Kindergarten to 5th grade that are currently enrolled in DSJ Catholic Schools or a Faith Formation Program are welcome to participate.




What
