The first such organization is even younger than the IEC. Black in Engineering (BIE) began in 2020 with a meeting organized by Dr. Carlotta Berry, Dr. Monica Cox, and Dr. Tahira Reid Smith. Carlotta is a great contact for us because she is a professor of ECE at Rose-Hulman. If you visit the Black in Engineering website, you will find that its ‘purpose is to support black faculty, researchers, practitioners and students in engineering and to serve as a resource for community building, sharing experiences with implicit bias and systemic racism, providing action items to address racial injustice, and identifying collaborators and sponsors.’
