Join the IEC Working Groups

The IEC is actively soliciting IEC Member School participants to participate in several Working Groups designed to organize grant proposals for the INCLUDES Alliance, EHR Racial Equity in STEM Education, and CISE Broadening Participation in Computing (BPC) Alliance.

Each member institution is asked to select a Working Group of interest and to submit a representative to participate.

Working Groups include:

- **Messaging & Identity Development Working Group** - Increase interest in, and motivation for, the study of computer engineering for African American/Black and Hispanic/Latino students, and especially women in these demographics.
- **Transitions Working Group** - Studying and refining interventions, programs, course/curriculum, and repositories designed to increase the number of URM students who persist in engineering and enhance their preparation for engineering practice.
- **Shared Curriculum Working Group** - Develop online asynchronous computing courses and modules to support competency-based assessment, tracking the development of a CPE student by level rather than grades.
- **Mentoring & Professional Development Working Group** - Implement a program to enhance faculty mentoring skills and mentoring of students in career pathways in computer engineering.
- **Academy, Industry & Community Engagement Working Group** - Fully engage Industry and Community in all aspects of AISCpE directly and by partnering with other BPC Alliances.
