| SB 1 by Huffman | General Appropriations Bill. Appropriates funds for 6.8 pennies of additional and "settle-up" school district M&O tax rate compression under current law mechanism. TY25: \$0.0532; TY26: \$0.0148. | \$3,023.8 | \$3,023.8 | In Conference Committee |

| HB 9/HJR 1 by Meyer | Increases the business personal property tax exemption to \$125,000 (from \$2,500). | Cannot be determined | Cannot be determined | Voted out of Senate Local Government on May 5 |
| SB 32/SJR 81 by Bettencourt | Increases the business personal property tax exemption to \$25,000 (from \$2,500) and provides a 20% franchise tax credit for property taxes paid on inventory. \$500 million per year statewide limit. | | \$713.7 | Referred to House Ways and Means on April 22 (SB 32) and April 17 (SJR 81) |
| SB 4/SJR 2 by Bettencourt | Increases the mandated school district general homestead exemption to \$140,000 (from \$100,000). | \$2,743.5 | \$2,743.5 | Voted out of House Ways and Means on May 5 |
| SB 23/SJR 85 by Bettencourt | Increases the mandated school district homestead exemption for 65+ or disabled to \$60,000 (from \$10,000). Coupled with increase in general homestead exemption provides a \$200,000 total homestead exemption. | \$1,207.2 | \$1,207.2 | Voted out of House Ways and Means on May 5 |
