

Q: When traveling abroad, what is the best way to obtain cash?

A: Oye! With over 25-years of personal/business travel, the short answer is an ATM. Here are some things to remember:

- Before traveling, check with your bank to get a list of banking partners to avoid ATM fees
- Notify your bank that you will be using an ATM abroad to prevent any fraud blocking of your card
- The maximum daily withdrawals will be the same overseas as in the U.S., so verify the amount before you travel.
- Different banks charge different exchange rates, so check daily to find which bank offers the best rates.
- Bring any unused currency back to your bank for the best exchange rates.
