

ITAA Conference 2021 – COVID safety measures

Your safety is important to us and in order to ensure the safety of all delegates we would like to advise the following:

- All conference delegates and attendees must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- There will be mandatory lateral flow testing on the morning of the conference.

Note: If a delegate's lateral flow test is positive they must self-isolate for the rest of the conference and will be responsible for any additional expense.

If you wish you can have an antigen test prior to departure – this is not compulsory but will confirm you are COVID free before you travel.

You will be requested to scan a copy of your Digital Covid Certificate directly to the hotel by e-mail in advance of arrival in order to speed up your check in. This will be shared with the hotels and restaurant venues to ensure ease of access.

Please note that you will need to show your Digital Covid Certificate on arrival at the Pousada de Estremoz for the Gala Dinner on Saturday 16th October.

Your Digital Covid Certificate will be required to travel.

All delegates must complete the [Passenger Locator Card](#) before departure to Portugal.

All transfers, seating and meals will be socially distanced in accordance with the local regulations of Portugal valid at the time of travel.

Please ensure that you have COVID cover included in your Travel Insurance.

Health and safety guidelines

It is important that all delegates follow the Covid health and safety guidelines:

- If you develop a cough, shortness of breath or a fever you should stay at home and follow the guidelines for self-isolation
- By wearing face masks when required – while flying, using transfers etc.
- By practicing hand hygiene and maintaining physical distancing.
