An early ending to the 2020 Legislative Session. The Maryland General Assembly passed more than 650 bills in a three-day sprint. For the first time since the Civil War, the legislative session ended nearly three weeks early because of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. This is unprecedented and unlike ANYTHING I have ever seen in my seventeen+ years as a Maryland State Delegate.

An end-of-session letter will be sent soon and will review the legislation that was passed. These bills will be sent to Governor Hogan to either sign, veto or it could become law without his signature. I am anxious to share my insights about this historical session!
