Brenda spoke about the CDC recently released breastfeeding data from the National Immunization Survey (NIS) for babies born in 2015. The report shows that rates increased in ALL measures for breastfeeding in Kansas. <http://ksbreastfeeding.org/new-breastfeeding-rates-kansas/> She also spoke about the HHS Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) release a new systematic review of community, workplace, and health care system-based programs and policies
