



## TRAFFIC HAWK – SPEEDING VIOLATIONS

### Suspension Schedule – Resident (12-month cycle)

|                |   |
|----------------|---|
| First Offense  | warning letter – please slow down.                              |
| Second Offense | warning letter – please slow down or potential fine/suspension. |
| Third Offense  | one-week deactivated barcode                                    |
| Fourth Offense | two-week deactivated barcode                                    |
| Fifth Offense  | four-week deactivated barcode; beach suspension for 4 weeks     |

### Schedule of Suspensions – Vendor (12-month cycle)

|                |  |
|----------------|--|
| First Offense  | warning letter – please slow down and call to the vendor's office. |
| Second Offense | one-week deactivated barcode                                       |
| Third Offense  | one-month deactivated barcode                                      |

### Schedule of Suspensions – Renter/Lessee (12-month cycle)

|                |  |
|----------------|--|
| First Offense  | warning letter – please slow down or potential suspension.   |
| Second Offense | one-week deactivated pass of all duration above daily entry plus \$100 fine to owner of property.  |
| Third Offense  | one-month deactivated pass of all duration above daily entry plus \$100 fine to owner of property. |

### Schedule of Suspensions – Reckless Drivers (all) – Speeding at Twice the Posted Limit or Higher

|                |  |
|----------------|--|
| First Offense  | Two-week barcode deactivation of all vehicles registered and \$100 fine.                                 |
| Second Offense | Four Week barcode deactivation of all vehicles registered,<br>Four-week beach suspension and \$100 fine. |

### Enforcement Procedure

1. The General Manager has delegated authority to determine which alleged violations shall first be addressed by warning letter(s) one and two. The Traffic Hawk warning letters will be sent automatically by the system and signed by the Director of Safety and Loss Prevention.
2. If the General Manager deems a Notice of Violation letter should be sent, the Board is consulted prior to execution. If the violation has a previously Board approved schedule of fines or suspensions for it, the General Manager may proceed to issue the Notice of Violation letter with fourteen-day notification and advise the Board of that action.
3. The alleged violator must meet with the Compliance Committee within twenty-eight days of the date identified in the Notice of Violation letter.
4. If present, the alleged violator, or his/her counsel may provide written and oral argument to review, challenge and respond to the evidence presented by BBCA.
5. The Compliance Committee with a quorum and by majority vote at the hearing, will confirm or reject the fine and/or suspension proposed. If the Compliance Committee confirms the fine or suspension the notification will be provided to the violator within one business day and any fine will be due within seven days of that notice. If the Compliance Committee rejects the recommended suspension, the suspension is not enforced, and the violation eliminated.
6. A suspension may apply to use rights of the Common Areas and/or Beach Park.
