Literacy Mentor

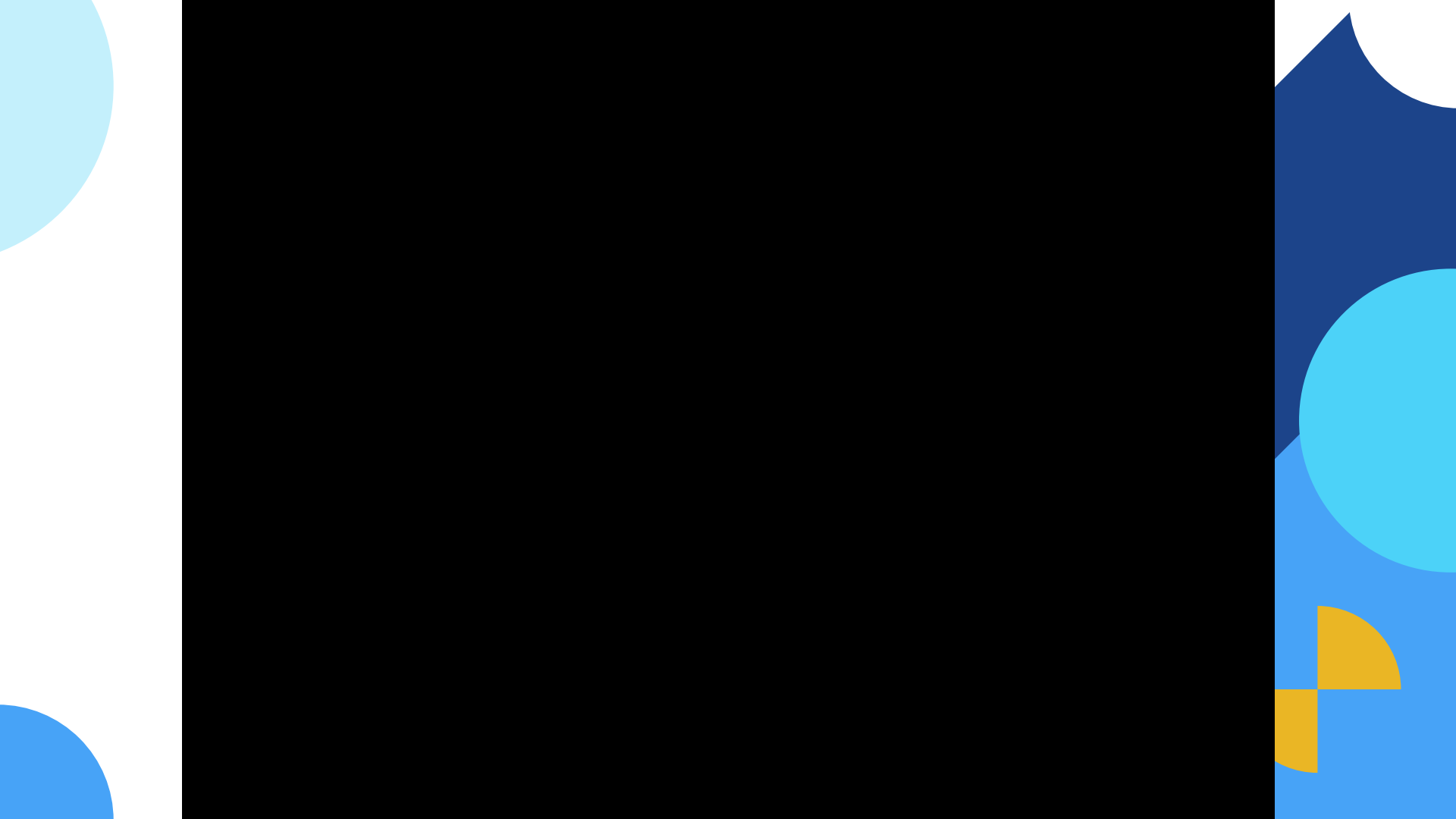


Mentors work with school-selected students 1 on 1 on their early reading skills at times coordinated with the classroom teacher. In K-2 focus on high frequency words and phonics; in 3-6 focus on WPM, reading comprehension and writing.

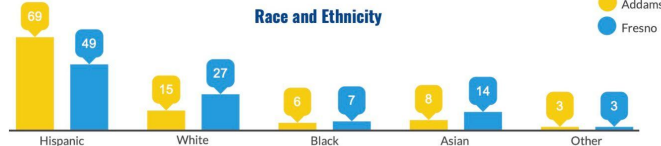

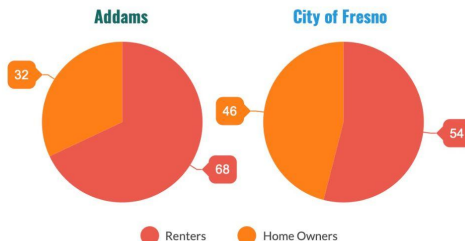

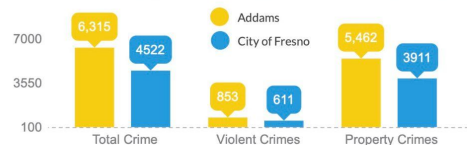
