

Guidelines for attending worship in the Sanctuary

1. Masks must be worn
2. Social distancing must be followed
3. Entry and Exit
 - a. if there is congestion in narthex, attendees are encouraged to exit via downstairs
 - b. attendees are encouraged to socialize outside if possible
4. A sign-in sheet and hand sanitizing supplies will be in the narthex
 - a. everyone must sign-in, a vital help should we need to do contact tracing
 - b. a picture will be taken once we are settled—again in case of a need to do contact tracing (it is helpful to know who in closest proximity)
5. All sanctuary doors MUST remain open
6. Seating
 - a. enter down center aisle, filling from front to back.
 - b. some pews will be blocked off for distancing purposes
 - c. one family per pew, or individuals sit at opposite ends of pew
 - d. the back pew exits first, using use side aisles.
7. Children's time – spaces will be marked
8. No Singing
 - a. all music is recorded
 - b. words on screen for reflecting or silent humming
9. Offerings will be dropped off in the narthex
10. Communion on first Sundays
 - a. prepackaged communion elements will be used
 - b. a gluten free, prepackaged option will be available
 - c. attendees can bring their own elements, if desired
 - d. attendees will be individually responsible to throw away communion packaging in the trashcan under the sign-in table
11. Bulletins
 - a. there will be no paper copies available – you are invited to print one and bring from home if you like
 - b. bulletins will continue to be available on the church website
 - c. announcements will be in the bulletin, as well as on screen prior to and after worship
12. Restroom use
 - a. Wipes/spray are provided for individuals to use as desired
13. There will be no Coffee Hour for the time being
