

Opened in 1926, the library is an architectural gem with a tiled pyramid on the roof, a mural-lined rotunda, and a modern Atrium Wing. ### **New Orleans and Cajun Country (P) February 16 – 23, 2020**

7 Days & 6 Nights – 6 Breakfasts, 4 Dinners

Spend a magnificent three days in the French Quarter of New Orleans, filled with fabulous restaurants and jazz clubs. Join a walking tour of the St. Louis Cathedral, Bourbon Street, and other sites. Board the steamboat Natchez for a cruise on the Mississippi River, followed by dinner at the Two Sisters. We visit the Garden District with its beautifully preserved southern mansions, and wander through Longue Vue Gardens and House. This morning we travel to Baton Rouge to view the new art deco State Capitol Building, hear stories about Huey Long (the states most famous politician) and wander through the Louisiana State Museum. Day 5 finds you in Natchez, Mississippi with a tour through an Antebellum Mansion, later crossing back into Louisiana to explore the fascinating Cajun country for a Bayou Cruise. Discover the Louisiana Lafitte Cultural Center to learn about the famous pirate, unlikely patriot, and about the area's Acadian heritage and the natural resources of the Louisiana's Mississippi Delta region. Then travel to Avery Island for a Tabasco Factory tour and tonight's "Farewell dinner" at Pont Breaux's, famous for its Cajun cuisine and sounds.

## **Arizona Spring Training – Baseball (F) March 8 – 12, 2020**

5 Days and 4 Nights – 4 Breakfasts and 2 Dinners

Travel by Motorcoach to Phoenix, Arizona, making friends with your fellow baseball enthusiasts. Then spend a morning at the Musical Instrument Museum with its display of over 6,500 instruments from around the world. Spend an afternoon at a Spring Training Baseball Game, followed by a morning at another game. Then tour the city of Phoenix including the state capitol and Frank Lloyd Wright's Taliesin West. Save your appetite for a Cowboy Dinner with all the fixings and a Wild West atmosphere. ## **Cultural Treasures of Japan (C) March 15-28, 2020**

14 Days & 12 Nights – 12 Breakfasts, 2 Lunches and 7 Dinners

Explore ancient and modern Japanese culture first hand. Your trip begins in Tokyo, a city filled with pop culture and long-kept traditions. View the city from the Tokyo Tower, stroll through the grounds of the Imperial Palace and the Kokyo Gaien National Gardens. Walk through the world's largest fish market before visiting the Meiji Shrine. Before leaving Tokyo, you will visit the geisha district and the famous Buddhist temple Senso-ji. Tokyo's old town of Yanaka Ginza houses quaint shops and vendors. A trip to the lakeside resort of Hakone is next, including a visit to the volcanic crater of Owakudani, take a cable car ride up the mountain, and then cruise on Lake Ashi. See Matsumoto's castle, the historic town of Takayama and visit a sake brewery. Spend a day at Shirakawa-go, a hidden village with thatched roof houses before going to Kanazawa, the origin of gold-leaf making. Here you will visit the Garden of Six Qualities and decorate your own lacquer box with old leaf. Follow with four days in Kyoto taking the bullet train, a ferry ride to Shrine Island, and visit Hiroshima and the Peace Memorial Park, a tour of the Inari shrine, and Nijo Castle, the home of the first Shogun. Finish with a lesson in the art of stenciling. Trip includes Roundtrip Airfare (LAX), deluxe motor coach transportation, hotel accommodations and transfers, luggage handling, and professional tour director.

Spend the day on a catamaran over the Great Barrier Reef, view the reef through a glass bottomed boat, and relax or snorkel on Green Island. A flight to Sydney takes you on a tour of the city and of Sydney's famous Opera House, then learn about opals at the National Opal Center. A day on your own ends with a dinner cruise of Sydney Harbor. Fly to Christchurch, New Zealand, the Garden City, which was devastated by an earthquake in 2011. After a day touring, eat dinner with a local family. A visit to the glaciers of the Mt. Cook region provides breathtaking views of the Alps. The gold rush town of Arrowtown highlights your bus trip to Queenstown. Cruise on breathtakingly beautiful Milford Sound as you spend your last three days in Queenstown. Explore the city, cruise Lake Wakatipu, and visit an authentic merino sheep farm before enjoying your farewell dinner overlooking Lake Wakatipu.

## **Sedona & Grand Canyon (F) May 17 - 21, 2020**

Our tour begins as we board our Motorcoach to Sedona, Arizona. Enjoy a welcome dinner amid the picturesque red rocks of Oak Creek. Day 2 we experience the beauty of Sedona's famous Red Rock Formations. Continuing on to Jerome, an artistic community today with art galleries, studios, and shops. Jerome was once a thriving copper mining town in the last 1880's. We end the day Uptown Sedona with time to browse the many boutiques, jewelry, and antique shops. Next morning we head out to Williams, Arizona to explore the Route 66 history. Evening brings a buffet dinner at the Grand Canyon Railroad Hotel. Day 4 we board the historic Grand Canyon Railway to journey in to the national Park, where we will join a bus for a guided tour. As we head out on Day 5, sit back and relax as we cruise along the scenic Route 66 toward home. Trip includes deluxe motor coach transportation, hotel accommodations and transfers, luggage handling, and professional tour director.

## **Oregon Trails and the Portland Rose Festival (P) June 4-10, 2020**

Begin your tour in Portland, the “City of Roses” with numerous gardens, museums, and other attractions. On day 2 you visit the Mt. St. Helens Volcanic National Monument and the Johnston Ridge Observatory, featuring information about the historic eruption. Tour Portland city including Washington Park, the International Rose Test Garden, and the Pittock Museum. Day 3 includes a visit to the Portland Rose Festival and the second largest all-floral parade in the U.S. Day 4 is a visit to Astoria, the northernmost city in Oregon to see where the Columbia River meets the Pacific Ocean. The Fort Clatsop National Memorial commemorates the 1805-6 winter encampment of the Lewis and Clark Expedition. Then travel along the scenic coastline to visit the Tillamook Cheese Factory for a tasty tour. Day 5 is a visit to Multnomah Falls, the second highest, year-round waterfall in the nation. A sternwheeler (paddlewheel) trip on the Columbia River provides a chance to learn more about the Lewis and Clark Expedition, followed by a visit to the Bonneville Dam.

Trip includes Roundtrip Airfare (LAX), deluxe motor coach transportation, hotel accommodations and transfers, luggage handling, and professional tour director.

Your last day in the city is a free day before your return flight to Los Angeles.

## **Waterways and National Parks of the Pacific Northwest (P) August 21 – 29, 2020**

Begin your trip in Seattle, Washington then head to the Chihuly museum of Glass and the 500 foot long Bridge of Glass. The Museum of Flight is one of the largest air and space museums in the world. Explore the Northwest Trek Wildlife Park and take a tram ride through the park, perhaps seeing native bison, elk, and moose. Then see Mount Rainier National Park with its active volcano rising over 14,000 feet. Spend a day in the Olympic National Park and the Hurricane Ridge Visitor Center. Then spend a day taking the ferry to Vancouver Island, Canada (passport required) to see the Butchart Gardens, and the Victoria City Tour featuring the Parliament Building and the Empress Hotel. A ferry ride takes you back to Seattle and a city tour with a visit to the Space Needle, Pioneer Square, and the Chittendon Locks and Fish Ladders.

## **Yellowstone, Grand Tetons and Mount Rushmore (F) September 1 – 9, 2020**

9 Days & 8 Nights – 8 Breakfasts, 1 Box Lunch, 4 Dinners

Fly to Jackson, WY, then follow the Snake River for a view of the Grand Tetons with picture taking stops. Visit Yellowstone's West Thumb Geyser Basin and see the Grand Prismatic and Old Faithful. You will see Mammoth Terrace Tower Falls and the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone, along with Norris Geyser Basin and the nearby museum. On the way to Keystone, MT, visit the Devil's Tower formation, followed by Mount Rushmore. A visit to the Badlands National Park and the Crazy Horse Memorial is capped by a nighttime blast at the memorial. The following day you visit Chimney Rock National Historic site and Scotts Bluff National Monument on your way to Cheyenne, WY. You also visit Park City, UT on your way to Salt Lake City and your flight home. Trip includes airfare, deluxe motor coach transportation, hotel accommodations and transfers, luggage handling, and professional tour director.

Explore the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center and learn about the early Native American population, and the Los Alamos Bradbury Science Museum to learn about the Manhattan Project and the atomic bomb. Travel the "High Road to Taos" passing through villages from the 1700s and the Spanish village of Chimayo. Tour Taos and the Taos Pueblo. End in Santa Fe with a city tour and a farewell dinner.

## **Albuquerque Balloon Fiesta and Santa Fe (F) October 9 – 14, 2020**

Then visit the International Balloon Museum and a city tour of Albuquerque, including the Indian Pueblo Cultural Center and old Town Albuquerque. A visit to Pueblo and Taos NM where you will be introduced to the history of the area and the Spanish and Native American cultures. The following day take a tour of Santa Fe, including the Governor's Plaza, Loretto Chapel and the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum. Trip includes airfare, deluxe motor coach transportation, hotel accommodations and transfers, luggage handling, and professional tour director.
