VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Homebound Meal Driver	Deliver a hot meal and a warm greeting to homebound seniors one morning a week from 9:30 to 11:30. Training will be provided. Minimum age 21 – Fingerprinting, Driver's License and proof of auto insurance required. TB test required for this position.
Village Transportation Driver	Help homebound seniors with transportation to a medical appointment, the grocery store or other vital services. Rides will be needed a few times a month based on your availability.
Adult Day Care Volunteer**	Support and assist in activities for memory impaired seniors. Assist with arts and crafts projects, meals, games, and social activities throughout the day. Training: Tour, Orientation, and activities. Minimum age 14 – Proof of TB test is required before starting volunteer hours. Weekdays 9am to 4:00pm. A minimum of 4 weeks is required for this position.
Childcare Volunteer**	Assist with infants and children 6 weeks to 5 years old. Support staff in providing a safe, warm and healthy learning environment. Minimum age 14. Proof of TB test, influenza, pertussis and measles vaccinations are required before starting volunteer hours. Childcare is available to volunteer on the weekdays between 9:00am -12:00, or 3:30-5:30pm. A minimum of 4 weeks is required for this position.
<u>Farmers Market Volunteer**</u>	Support the farmers and staff at the market. Positions include greeting at the front gate, helping with children's activities and assisting small business. <u>Sunday</u> morning from 7:00am – 1:00 pm. Minimum age 14, 12-14 can attend with a parent. No partial shifts allowed. Please email the week before you plan on attending.
Telephone Reassurance	Make phone calls to seniors within our community to check on their well-being while having a social visit. Calls are made from the ONEgeneration Senior Enrichment Center.
Special Projects Volunteer	Register to be included as a special projects volunteer. Projects range from stuffing envelopes, filling, decorating or helping with an event. Join a committee for special events to help with sponsorships, securing silent auction items and more!
Dining Site Volunteer	Assist with serving food to participants in lunch programs. ONEgeneration has five locations where lunch is served Monday through Friday. On-site training with Dining Coordinator.
Administrative Support	Help with clerical and reception assistance.

Teacher	Teach a class to seniors at one of our sites. Looking for teachers for the following classes: Book Club, Square Dancing, Ballet and Bridge. Help in the fitness Center.
Entertainer	Entertainers needed for the lunch program at the Senior Enrichment Center and the Adult Daycare.
Computer Tutoring**	Teaching seniors basic computer skills, internet, e-mail and word processing programs. Tutoring is done one on one, not in a classroom setting. Minimum age 14. Mentor times are based on the mentor's availability.
Intergenerational Program	Programs for seniors to participate with youth in structured programs designed to involve the students in life skills, arts, nutrition, and a variety of fun engaging activities.
