The **Family-to-Family Education Program** is a series of twelve weekly classes <u>for family members and caregivers</u> of individuals with a mental illness. The trained co-teachers are family members themselves and know what it's like to have a loved one struggling with one of these brain disorders. The course balances education and skill-training with self care, emotional support and empowerment.

This class is the first step to help your loved one on the road to recovery. For family members, partners and friends of individuals with:

Major Depression
Bipolar Disorder (Manic Depression)
Schizophrenia and Schizoaffective Disorder
Borderline Personality Disorder
Panic Disorder and Obsessive Compulsive Disorder
Co-occurring Brain Disorders and Addictive Disorders
Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
