






IECF SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION







DEADLINE: May 18, 2018

The purpose of the IEC Foundation Scholarship Fund is to provide annual need-based scholarships to further the academic goals of students that are in an IEC-approved apprenticeship program or similar post-secondary education.

Scholarship awards range from \$500 up to a maximum of \$1,500 and are to be used for tuition and/or books. Awards for each scholarship winner will be paid directly to your IEC training center/college for your benefit. Awards will be awarded in the following categories:

-  **Craft** – Students in an IEC-approved apprenticeship program.
-  **Baccalaureate** – Students pursuing a baccalaureate degree in fields associated with the electrical industry.
-  **Continuing college education** for journeymen part-time college students who are employed full-time by an IEC contractor member may be eligible for a \$500 scholarship if they are studying toward a degree relative to the electrical industry.

Applicants to The IEC Foundation Scholarship Fund must be:

-  A high school graduate (or GED Equivalency);
-  A U.S. citizen, or are legally living/working in the United States;
-  Apprentices enrolled in an IEC-approved apprenticeship program, or
-  Students enrolled in a full-time college program (12 or more credit hours) pursuing a degree in the electrical industry; or
-  Journeymen enrolled part-time in a college program (less than 12 credit hours) AND working full-time for an IEC member and pursuing a degree in the electrical industry;
-  And, sponsored/employed by a member of the Independent Electrical Contractors (IEC)

A. Complete all sections within this application - type or neatly print responses on the application form.

B. Required attachments to application (in this order):

1. A digital photograph of applicant

Note: Photographs must be color photographs of the applicant only, with applicant dressed and groomed professionally in a clean company uniform shirt or a clean collared shirt

2. Applicant Statement (see description within this form) of 300-500 words
3. Letter(s) from any organization where you perform/performed a service to the community
4. Attach cumulative transcript that includes grades for most recently completed semester

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The selection committee will evaluate each applicant according to criteria established by the IEC Foundation. The criteria generally focus on a combination of the student's academic merit, interest in the electrical industry, letter of recommendation from sponsor, the description of student and why this field was chosen, and community involvement, as shown below. The personal data listed on the front sheet will not be furnished to the selection committee, so it is a blind selection process.
