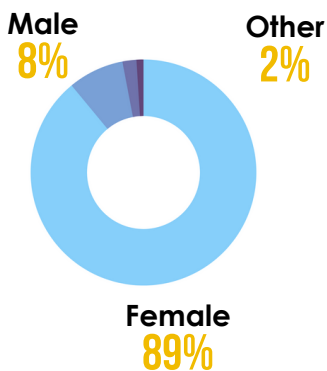


The Open Doors Outreach Network launched in 2017 to provide 24/7/365 services to sex trafficked children and young adults ages 10-24. As of June 30, 2022, Open Doors Outreach Network Providers have served 1,503 individuals since inception.

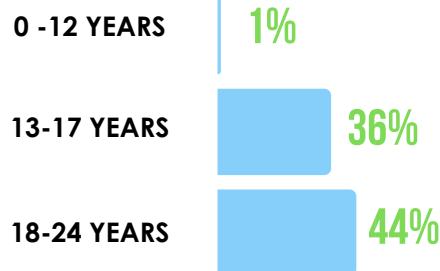
Of those served this past quarter (April - June 2022), 83 were new and had not previously received services from Open Doors. Open Doors has provided 18,251.05 hours of direct service to survivors this quarter, totaling 185,062.20 hours of direct service provision to date.

POPULATION SERVED TO DATE:

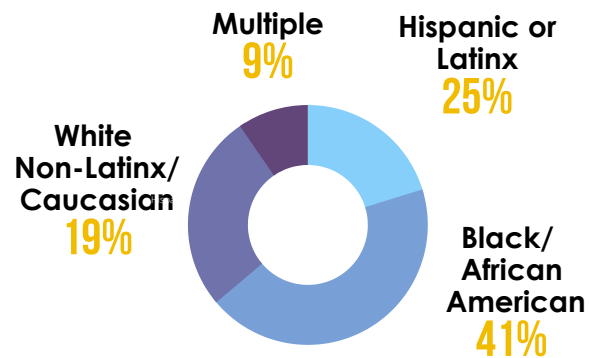
GENDER IDENTIFICATION
