Temporary Assistance for Needy Families



The 477 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) department assists low-income Alaska Native/American Indian families with dependent children to become self-sufficient. The department also provides adult-not-included benefits to families with a disabled parent or other non-needy caretaker relative.

Monthly financial assistance is provided to families along with the following support services available either directly or through coordination and referral:

- » Basic Education
- » Child Care
- » Community Services & Job Sampling Placement
- » Job Development
- » Job Search Activities
- » On-the-Job Training
- » Post-Employment Services
- » Social Services
- » Transportation
- » Vocational Training
