## Always Inspect Before Use

Check for damage, wear, and cleanliness. Do not use if any part is compromised.

## Store Respirators Correctly

Keep in a clean, dry place away from contaminants when not in use.

## Replace Filters and Cartridges as Required

Follow manufacturer guidelines and replace when breathing becomes difficult or when expiry dates are reached.

## Use the Right Respirator for the Job

Select the correct type based on the hazard.

## Ensure a Proper Fit

Ensure you complete regular seal checks and fit tests

## Facial Hair Can Affect the Seal

Be clean-shaven where the respirator seals to the face to ensure proper protection.
