Take the opportunity to view the Okavango Panhandle from the air when staying at Nxamaseri Island Lodge. The helicopter doors are removed from aircraft to give guests uninterrupted views of the Okavango Panhandle and the surrounding scenery.

Departing from Nxamaseri Island Lodge, the route enjoyed will depend on the choice of the flight time. The scenic flight will traverse over the Okavango Panhandle, followed by a flight around the Tsodilo Hills Cultural Heritage Site.

Enjoy a 30-minute helicopter flight over the Boteti River or extend the flight into the Makgadikgadi Pans on a 60-minute flight. Our partners at Helicopter Horizons will remove the doors providing uninterrupted views and close up angles of the unique landscape. A scenic flight is not just a must for keen photographers but an exciting opportunity to gain insight into the uniqueness of the Boteti River on the edge of the dry Makgadikgadi National Park.

Departing from Leroo La Tau, the 30-minute flight concentrates on the Boteti River which forms the western boundary to the Makgadikgadi Pans National Park. The flight will allow travellers to enjoy the annual zebra migration from a unique perspective as thousands of zebra make their way onto the river banks to drink.

The 60-minute scenic flight travels further out into the Makgadikgadi Pans for a chance to witness the expanse of the salt pans. The flight includes a stop on the pans allowing guests to walk on the pans and experience their expansiveness from the ground. The first and last 10 mins of the flight will also be following the Boteti River as with the 30-minute flight.

For the ultimate Makgadikgadi Pans scenic flight adventure head out over the expansive salt pans towards Kubu Island where the helicopter will touch down and allow you time to explore this enchanting island. Gondwanaland rocks combine with archaeological remains and giant mystical baobab trees that form one of the most stunning settings in Africa. After your time on the island the pilot will travel south in search of flamingo flocks and nesting sites, one of Africa's most important lesser & greater flamingo colonies. The flamingo movements vary each year depending on the timing and volume of rain (typically February – July). On return the pilot will fly via the Boteti River to catch the zebra migration (May – November) and other wildlife congregating along the riverfront before returning to Leroo La Tau.

An immersive 4 hour adventure by helicopter to the remote Eretsha village where guests will first help cattle farmers from a local community group, CLAWS (Communities Living Among Wildlife Sustainably) release their cattle from the corral to feed for the day, within the outer reaches of the Okavango Delta.

The adventure continues to the center of the Eretsha village where community members of the Life With Elephants project, run by the NGO Ecoexist, amuse guests with story telling and reenactments before a humbling and rewarding walk through the village finishes off the experience. The icing on the cake as one last helicopter flight over the Okavango Delta and back to the lodge for brunch.

A thrilling scenic flight from the Okavango Delta or Moremi Game Reserve makes the UNESCO World Heritage site of Tsodilo Hills an exciting cultural excursion for guests staying at Camp Okavango, Xugana Island Lodge, Camp Moremi and Camp Xakanaxa.

After a beautiful scenic flight over the Okavango Delta, guests are met by their local guide for a half-day excursion of the Tsodilo Hills. Over 4 500 rock paintings, some dating back an estimated 26 000 years, adorn the marshmallow-coloured quartzite rocks.

NOTES REGARDING ALL HELICOPTER BOOKINGS:

- There is a helicopter permanently stationed at Xugana Island Lodge. Bookings are however subject to availability at the time of booking.
- There is no helicopter based at Leroo La Tau or Nxamaseri Island Lodge. Pre-booking is essential to plan for the necessary helicopter movements.
- Guests can book any of the below helicopter flights during their stay in camp as an additional activity. In this instance, the quoted RACK rate will be charged directly to the clients and settled in camp.
- All pre-booked flights are fully non-refundable. In the case of cancellation by Helicopter Horizons due to unforeseen circumstances (weather, aircraft maintenance, etc.), the cost of the flight will be refunded to the agent, subject to approval.
