**How to find Arc-en-Provence in Lorgues (Peter and Shirley Massey's home)
1801 Chemin des Pailles, 83510 Lorgues**

From Vidauban or Les Arcs: When you reach the roundabout in Lorgues turn right towards Draguignan; Go about 200 m to the next roundabout and take the third exit, Route de Draguignan. Go about 1km until you come to a builders materials yard, called "CIEFFREO BONA" on your right, and turn right into **Chemin des Pailles**. Follow all the way down 1.8 kms until you reach the little Chapel Notre Dame de Florièye and turn left onto the gravel road and the house is about 100 m back in the trees.

From Carces and Salernes: Follow all the way round Lorgues onto the Route de Draguignan and then directions as above. **From Draguignan:** As you approach Lorgues turn left immediately before "CIEFFREO BONA"; and then directions as above.
