APPLYING TO CAPU FOLLOWING NOMINATION ACCEPTANCE

Step 1: Email studyabroad@capilanou.ca to obtain an application fee waiver code (one per student).

Step 2: Apply online through EducationPlanner BC, by submitting the following items:

- 1. Proof of English Language Proficiency based on regular <u>English</u> <u>Language Requirements</u> or a letter from home institution that guarantees the level of English.
- 2. Post-secondary transcripts, including certified translation in English, where applicable. These must be sent by the home institution to be considered official.
- 3. Letter of Permission from home institution, indicating the applicant is in good standing at the home institution and program/term they are approved to take at CapU.
- 4. Personal email address
- 5. Portfolio (IDEA students only)

Step 3: The student (cc: partner) receives an acknowledgement letter, which includes the student details such as Student ID Number, email address, and instructions on how to log into myCapU account and track the application status.

Step 4: The student (cc: partner) receives a **letter of acceptance**, which includes information related to study permit, course registration, accommodation, and orientation.

STAYING CONNECTED Exchange students will receive a CapU email address, and access to their myCapU Account and eLearn learning portal. All official communication will be sent to the student's CapU email address, so we highly recommend checking it regularly. REGISTERING FOR CAPU COURSES

Step 1: Prior to registering for CapU courses, all students must submit their course requests by completing the Exchange Student Course Approval Form (fillable pdf) and emailing it to studyabroad@capilanou.ca. Students can choose from a list of upper-level courses from their area of study. (Exception: CapU's Bachelor of Motion Picture Arts Program students will receive a list of recommended and pre-approved courses for their course approval form.) Before requesting any course approvals, students are advised to work with their home institution to ensure that their credits earned at CapU are transferrable back to their home institution. Students are welcome to mix and match courses within the approved exchange programs. Specific courses outside these programs are limited and seats are subject to approval though we will do our very best to accommodate desired course requests. Most CapU courses have 3.0 credits. Exchange students must take a minimum of three (3) CapU courses (to maintain a full time student status) and can take a maximum* of four (4) courses at CapU. *Exception: MOPA students take 4-5 courses

Step 2: Study Abroad Team will keep the student informed of their course approvals and support with course approval requests.

Step 3: Students register on their own using myCap Schedule.

FEES

Tuition and School Fees | Exchange students pay tuition to their home university. Students should also budget for books, supplies, and specific mandatory school fees. **Note:** Fee-paying exchange students pay all tuition and additional school fees to CapU.

Health Insurance | All incoming exchange students must be enrolled in <u>guard.me</u>, a private health insurance company contracted by CapU. This basic health insurance, at \$2.00 per day, is mandatory and ensures our exchange students have adequate coverage during their stay, regardless of individual health plans.

UPass | All exchange students must pay for a subsidized student transportation pass called <u>UPass BC</u> (\$173.40 per term).

VISA AND STUDY PERMIT

Before applying, students are advised to <u>find out if they need a study permit</u> or <u>eTA or visa</u> and read our latest <u>frequently asked questions</u> and <u>Information for International Students Travelling to Canada</u>.

ARRIVAL

Airport: Vancouver International Airport (YVR)

Pickup: CapU does not organize airport pickup. The Canada Line is an affordable transportation connection to downtown Vancouver and the city of Richmond. From downtown Vancouver, <u>SeaBus</u> is a convenient and scenic connection to North Vancouver. Also, see: Information for International Students Travelling to Canada.

ACCOMMODATION

CapU offers student residence close to campus. Rooms in residence include meals, Wi-Fi, access to laundry, and more. Exchange students will receive information about application deadlines and steps to apply with their Letter of Acceptance. They also have other options for accommodation, which they may contact directly: host family in a homestay environment or fully furnished shared housing with other students. We strongly advise students to ensure they understand all conditions and refund policies of their accommodation before signing their contracts.

STUDY ABROAD AMBASSADOR (BUDDY) PROGRAM

Exchange students will be matched with "buddies" (study abroad ambassadors) who have already experienced a term abroad at one of CapU's partner institutions. TRANSCRIPT & COURSE TRANSFER

CapU uses a <u>letter grade system</u>. Upon successful completion of their exchange term, students may request their official transcript through their <u>myCapU Account</u>. For details, see <u>Transcripts and Forms</u>. Our Study Abroad Team will email a digital copy of the transcript to the partner institution. Students are responsible to ensure their credits earned at CapU are transferrable to their home institution.
