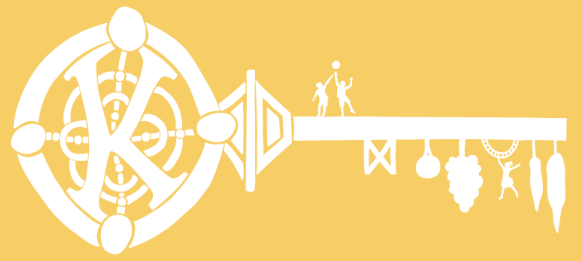


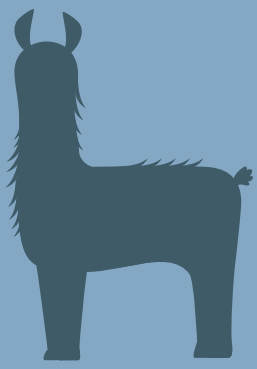

LEARNING OPTIONS

THE METRIC:

All Metrics for opening, hybrid, or closing are based on a 7-day rolling average of diagnosed cases in zip codes specific to Keystone families and/or Oklahoma County.

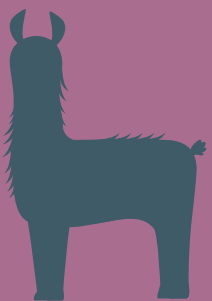


METRIC: Campus will be fully open when cases are fewer than 25 per day.

MISSION CONTROL KASAF

In the fully open campus scenario (our goal and hope!), students and families and staff will be expected to follow safety protocols, including face coverings, physical distancing, and temperature checks. We will utilize outdoor classrooms & spaces.

The school day will be extended by 30 minutes to allow older children more time for instruction.



SPACE COLONY KASAF



METRIC: Hybrid Learning will commence when daily diagnosed cases are between 25-50.

In the event of a **temporary Hybrid Learning scenario**, each classroom will be divided into an "A" Group and a "B" Group. Each group will be on campus at Keystone every other day. On their non-campus days, students will participate in Virtual Learning. The school day will be extended by 30 minutes to allow for more instruction.



GROUP A: Attends MWF for Week 1; T/TH for Week 2; participates virtually with the on-campus group.



GROUP B: Attends T/TH for Week 1; MWF for Week 2; participates virtually with the on-campus group.

SATELLITE KASAF



METRIC: Virtual Learning will commence at more than 50 diagnosed cases per day. (Small groups on campus still a possibility.)



In the event of a **temporary Virtual Learning scenario**, learning will be expanded from the spring model to include a stronger emphasis on individualization, small group instruction, online socialization, and, where possible, small group meet-ups on campus for specials like PE or pasture.
