SVRI Assistive Technologists will be available to diagnose potential repairs and perform routine cleaning and maintenance adjustment procedures.

- Tighten fasteners
- Check tire pressure, bearings and spokes
- Check wheel alignment
- Adjust seating and positioning
- Adjust mechanical/electrical settings
- Lubricate
- Evaluate seat cushions and back rests
- Adjust wheel-locks

Appointments are suggested, but walk-ins are welcome.
