This year we are playing Fairbanks Ranch Country Club's championship golf course. This premier resort-style property offers a truly unforgettable golf experience for players of all skill levels. The Valley, Lakes, and Ocean "Nines" combine 27 picturesque, walkable holes into three different course layouts. The first 18 holes were designed by Ted Robinson, the additional nine holes were designed by Ted Robinson Jr.

Fairbanks Ranch offers terrific views, wide, sweeping fairways and undulating greens encircled by palm trees to pristine, sparkling lakes and elevated tee shots. In addition to the beautiful aesthetics, the course offers challenging play for golfers at every skill level. Well-groomed fairways and greens keep Fairbanks Ranch difficult yet friendly, and the staff can offer tips and tricks for playing your best round.

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SPONSORSHIPS

SIGN SPONSOR \$150

Sign with your company logo on the course. Does not include golfers or participation in the tournament.

PUTTING CONTEST SPONSOR \$250 (1 AVAILABLE)

Includes sign with your company logo on the putting green during registration. Does not include golfers or participation in the tournament. You work with golf course to design putting contest. You provide prize for winner(s).

DEDICATED HOLE SPONSOR \$750 (12 AVAILABLE)

Includes Dedicated Hole on the course, one table and two chairs. You will be the only sponsor at the hole. You may serve food and non-alcoholic drinks. Does not include golfers.

DEDICATED HOLE DRINK SPONSOR \$750 (6 AVAILABLE)

Includes Dedicated Hole on the course, one table and two chairs. You will be the only sponsor at the hole. You may serve food and drinks (BYO). Does not include golfers. Fairbanks Ranch will allow drink sponsors to bring and serve their own alcohol as long as the person serving has an RBS certificate. (see below for more info)

ABC ALCOHOL SERVER CERTIFICATION EXAM

The California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) requires any person serving alcohol to have a valid Responsible Beverage Service (RBS) certificate. 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Fairbanks Ranch Country Club General Etiquette

Proper etiquette for all golfers begins upon arrival at the Club and continues through the round and until the golfer leaves the property. Use locker rooms for changing into or out of golf attire and shoes. The changing of shoes or clothes is prohibited anywhere other than in the locker rooms.

DRESS CODE

Shoes: Only golf shoes with soft spikes or sneakers are permitted.

Shirts: All golf shirts must have a collar or be golf-specific sportswear. Shirts without collars must have sleeves. Golf shirts must be tucked in at all times while on property. Tommy Bahama-style, button-down shirts are permitted to be worn untucked.

Shorts and Skirts: Appropriate golf shorts, skirts, and culottes are permitted, but they should not be any shorter than mid-thigh. Shorts are permitted all day in the Clubhouse, and until 5:00 pm in the Dining Room.

Hats: Hats, visors, and caps or hoods with bills facing forward may be worn at all times outside the Clubhouse but are not allowed in the Clubhouse other than in the golf shop.

Not Allowed: Denim, athletic shorts, non-golf fitness attire, tank tops, halter tops, cutoff shorts and sweat clothes are not allowed on the golf course.

MUSIC

Music on golf carts is permitted providing it is kept at a volume to not disturb others in the group.

FIX YOUR DIVOTS

Upon completion of a shot, divots shall be replaced or fixed with provided sand and ball marks on greens repaired.

CELL PHONES

Cell phone conversations are permitted only in the main lobby, food and beverage serving areas, and outdoor areas of Club facilities.

Cell phone use is not permitted in the locker rooms or driving range. Ringers must be off or on vibration mode on the golf course and driving range. Speaker phone, FaceTime or loud or disruptive cell phone use is prohibited in public places.

CARTS

Carts may only be driven onto the grass when and where allowed. Carts are to be kept on cart paths as much as possible consistent with efficient play.

Anyone driving a cart must have a valid driver's license. A maximum of two carts will be assigned per foursome.

Carts must stay on cart paths around tees and greens.

Carts are never to be driven onto the course past restraining ropes. Carts should not be driven closer than 50 yards of the green.

Whenever carts are allowed off paths, we ask that you scatter the carts about the hole (fairway or rough) and return to path when prompted to do so. Carts must follow arrows and cart signs, particularly in front of or around the greens and on fairways.

There are times when valid handicap flags allow modification of the above rules.

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
