Church Name: Alfa & Omega Iglesia de los Hermanos (Alpha & Omega Church of the Brethren)

Pronunciation: AHL-fah ee oh-MEH-gah ee-GLAY-syah deh lohs ehr-MAH-nohs. [Listen to it.](#)

Name Meaning: It is based on the book of Revelation and means “the first and the last,” symbolizing that Christ is eternal.
