

John R. Yeatts is Professor Emeritus at Messiah College and Senior Pastor Emeritus of Grantham Church. He pastored the Fairland Church in Lebanon, Pennsylvania, and the Brethren in Christ Church in Grantham. He served on the faculty at Messiah College for 33 years and still teaches a course every year. He also taught at Daystar University in Nairobi, Kenya, the Theological College of Central Africa and Evangelical University in Ndola, Zambia, the Theological College of Zimbabwe in Bulawayo, and the Evangelical Bible College of Malawi in Blantyre. With his wife Amy, he has a son and a daughter, two grandsons, and three granddaughters.



Course Description

Devotion and Worship in the Book of Revelation: People say that they do not understand the Book of Revelation. Yet, they understand it every Sunday morning when they sing it in songs and use it in worship. This course assumes that treating Revelation as a puzzle book predicting when Jesus will come again diverts our attention away from what Jesus told us to do – witness to the one who is coming, the slaughtered Lamb, Jesus the Christ. This course will treat the Book of Revelation as devotional and worship material strengthening our witness to the one whose coming we await with joy and anticipation.

This FREE 10-week class will begin at Lancaster COB on Wednesdays, starting October 3–December 12, 2018 from 6:30-7:30 p.m. There will be no class on November 21 (the eve of Thanksgiving Day).
