Groups of COB churches, with the help of the ANE District, are sponsoring a service project in the Washington, DC area. We invite any other COB church **Senior High age group** to participate in the Service Weekend.

The weekend is limited to 45 Senior High Youth including advisors. Please forward individual registration and payment to District Office (checks payable to ANE District, memo line DC Project). By sending the completed registration form(s) BY NOV 1st deadline, you are committing that those individuals will be participating. (Transportation to DC provided by participants' church or churches grouping together – if transportation is a deal breaker, see Ed Haldeman.)

OUTLINE OF WEEKEND:

- Arrive Friday, November 21st, Hempfield COB at 5:30 pm to pack and depart 6:00 pm. We will arrive at our lodging destination (Trinity Presbyterian Church, 5533 16th St N, Arlington, VA 22205) around 9:00 – 9:30 pm. Bring a sleeping bag and something to sleep on if you wish (there are no beds), toiletries, work clothes, closed-toed shoes, and nicer clothing for Sunday's church service.
- Saturday's work project day, we will provide breakfast Saturday morning and a bag lunch Saturday while on project. Saturday night we will most likely go out for dinner (**your expense – fast food meal, casual dress**). Please advise us of special dietary needs regarding supplied meals.
- Sunday, we will provide breakfast and then off to worship at St. Stephen's (suggest you bring offering money) and leave from there to arrive back at Hempfield COB late afternoon. If more specific details are desired, contact Ed Haldeman.

ATTENTION Advisors/Youth Leaders traveling with their group:

The purpose of the service project is to provide a means to allow our youth to "serve our brothers and sisters" and to that end, it is assumed that the advisor/leaders traveling with their respective youth have fulfilled the District requirements and are abiding by their church's policies for such an activity.
