RESTAURANTS



- Place a small canopy in the parking lot to cover pick-up/take-out locations
- Add a tent over the patio or courtyard to expand room for a lounge, bar or waiting area
- Add tents to create a fresh air bistro dining experience
- Place a tent next to restaurant to expand dining room seating capacity while accommodating social distancing
- Add a marquee over the sidewalk to shelter guests waiting in line to enter or pick up orders

GROCERY STORES



- Use marquee tents to cover the walkway or sidewalk for shoppers waiting in line to enter store
- Use small tents to service curbside pick-up locations
- Consider using a tent in the parking lot to create a fresh, locally sourced produce market
- Include a canopy to expand break space for employees

REALTORS



- Add a small tent in front of your office to cover clients as they wait to enter
- Consider a tent with privacy walls to use for quick paperwork review, contract signing and closing activities
- Use marquee tents to cover the walkway or sidewalk for clients waiting in line to enter Open Houses

BUSINESS OFFICES



- Use tents to cover employees during thermal scans and temperature testing
- Include tents and canopies to cover employees picking up PPE supplies, paychecks, or being assigned workstations
- Consider larger tents with additional seating to accommodate break room overflow to maintain social distancing
- Use a canopy to create outdoor space for vendors, delivery drivers and other visitors while they wait

BANKS



- Consider a tent with privacy walls to use for quick paperwork review, contract signing and other loan or banking transactions
- Small tents to cover customers waiting to enter the bank
- Tents to cover walkways for customers waiting in line to use ATM
- Include a canopy with tables and chairs to expand break space for employees

AUTOMOTIVE



- Install a tent for drive-thru service and inspections
- Place a small tent near the entrance to cover clients waiting for vehicles to be serviced
- Use a tent to expand garage space, creating a NASCAR style approach to engine and body repairs
- Add a colorful, eye-catching canopy for dealership promotions
- Expand employee break rooms with a canopy to adhere to social distancing



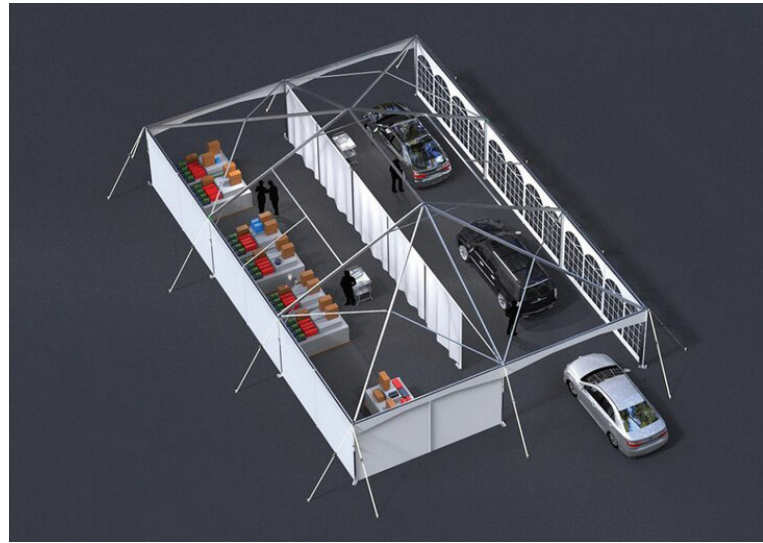

- A marquee for outdoor dining to help maintain social distancing
- Small tents at tee blocks to distance golfers waiting for their turn

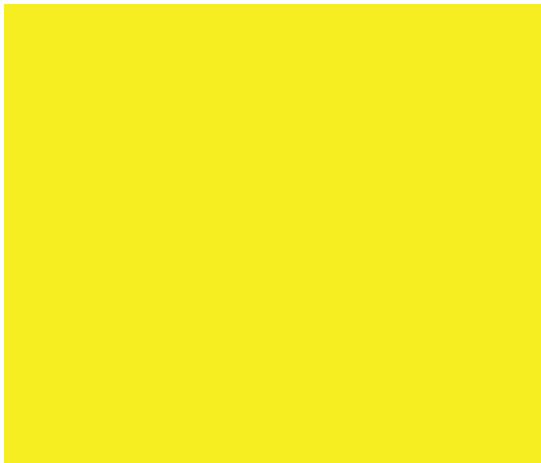
