JOB DESCRIPTION: Assist aquatic biologist with standardized sampling of ponds, lakes, reservoirs, streams, and rivers. Primary duties include sampling sportfish and native fish populations, performing fish population estimates, measuring and installing habitat, mapping lakes, assisting in spawn taking operations, stocking fish, performing chemical reclamations, maintaining equipment and facilities, and performing data entry and analysis. Technician must be willing to travel and work in inclement weather. Some late night and weekend work is required.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Candidates who have experience with fish sampling techniques, boat handling skills, and fish identification are encouraged to apply.
