

Rocky Mountain National Park Job Announcements

Rocky Mountain National Park will be hiring soon for 2021 summer **biological science technician** positions. Biological science technicians work on a wide range of natural resource management projects from restoring disturbed habitats using native plant material, assisting with forest regeneration, controlling exotic plant species, installing erosion control, collecting seeds, working in a greenhouse and nursery, managing and researching wildlife habitat, conducting rare plant surveys, mapping and monitoring plant populations, and much more. Rocky Mountain National Park is a great place to work. Consider applying to work with us next summer!

How do I apply?

The positions are expected to be posted on or around November 16th 2020 at <u>www.usajobs.gov</u> and will only be up for up to 5 days. If the applicant cap is reached before the 5 days, the announcement may close earlier. Qualified candidates will be contacted in January or February for interviews. Positions generally run from April to September (but timeframe can be shorter if you are a student).
