RE: COVID Vaccine Eligibility For Building Service Workers

Dear Governor Cuomo,

We are the Co-Presidents of the Presidents Co-op & Condo Council, an advocacy organization whose members represent over 100,000 residents in the City of New York. We were disappointed to learn that our Building Service Workers are not yet eligible to receive the COVID vaccine. As you are aware, our Building Service Workers were among the first to come back to work at the start of the pandemic.

Our workers who have been identified as “essential” workers, have been keeping our Buildings clean, safe, and warm throughout the pandemic. They often find themselves in resident’s apartments doing repairs or simply helping our seniors. Many of these workers were exposed to the virus and either tested positive or were quarantined. They have put themselves at risk on a daily basis doing what is right for the residential community of our city.

We strongly hope you will reconsider this decision and include our Building Service Workers in the pool of eligible persons to receive the vaccine ASAP.
