Cub & Friends Overnighter Planning Guide

Location:

Cub Scout Family Day is held at Camp Shenandoah, Swoope, VA

Check-In:

Check-In begins at 1:00pm. Please come to the check-in table located in front of the Camp Office.

Check-In is open until 2:30pm.

For Packs and individuals staying overnight you will be able to move gear to campsites between 4:00 and 6:00pm.

Parking:

Please observe and follow signs indicating where parking is and is not permitted. Carpooling is always encouraged.

Activities:

Activities will run from 2:00pm to 5:00pm; dinner will start with flags at 6:15pm followed by campfire at 7:30pm.

There is no rotation, you are able to move freely around the camp and visit all of the activities. All activities, including the shooting ranges, have a responsibility for your child's safety. They can and will ask anyone that is not following safety rules to leave the area. Please help them keep our families safe.

Dinner:

Dinner be provided or you can bring your own. Please let the Camp know one week in advance of any dietary needs or restrictions.

What to bring:

- 1. At least one water bottle per person.
- 2. Comfortable shoes (FLIP FLOPS OR OPEN TOED SHOES ARE NOT PERMITTED AT CAMP)
- 3. Please dress according to the weather. The event is entirely outside.
- 4. Bring a poncho, raincoat, or other rain gear with you. You may leave these items in your car. This is a rain or shine event.
- Overnight campers need to provide their own sleeping bag, toiletries, and other items needed for an overnight stay.
- Completed registration form and appropriate payment (cash or check, payable to "SJAC BSA")

Rules to help you plan:

- 1. Remember that we strongly suggest one adult per youth.
- 2. Please report any accidents to the Health Officer.
- 3. Remember that we are here for the boys and our goal is for the boys to have fun while learning about our camp.
- Vehicles may not be brought beyond the parking lot gate. NO riding in the back of trucks. NO pets or alcoholic beverages are permitted.
