August 13, 2020	Educator Community Forum & Discovery Education STEM Connect Workshop	Learn how to unlock the power of the Discovery Education license through Virtual STEM Studio.

January 13, 2021	Aligning Objectives with Inquiry Activities	In the first part of this two-part series, educators will learn how to use Bloom's taxonomy to align the objectives of an inquiry lesson to the activities built into that lesson.
February 10, 2021	Aligning Assessments with Inquiry Activities	In the second part of this series, educators will create an assessment idea aligned to the objective and method of learning for an inquiry lesson.
March 10, 2021	Preparing for STEM Studio – Summer 2021	Learn about the professional learning being offered in TGR EDU: Create during summer 2021 and how to join the opportunities.
April 14, 2021	Bringing Students Back to the Center	Compare teacher-centered to student-centering learning environments and learn about strategies to implement a student-centered classroom.
May 12, 2021	Project Based Learning in the Digital Classroom	Identify the components of project-based learning and apply a framework for implementing PBL during in-person and remote learning environments.
