

## Mission Opportunity

The SERVE Committee and the Methodist Men are sponsoring a Mission Opportunity. We will be partnering with SAWS (Servants At Work) to build a Wheelchair ramp for a 71-year stroke victim. To help with this mission there are several different ways you can help.

1. Assist with the prebuild on August 3<sup>rd</sup>. This will be at the SAWS workshop located off Layfette Street in the old Roxbury Nursery site. This will be the time that the frame and supports for the ramp are built. It starts at 9 and is usually done by 11:30.
2. Assist with the installing of the Ramp. This is where the various pieces from the prebuild are assembled and the decking and rails added. This starts on August 6 at 9 at the clients' house and is often done shortly after lunch.
3. The average cost of a build is \$2,500. If you would like to contribute to the cost of this build you may send a check directly to SAWS or contribute through the church offering with it designated to SAWS.
4. Assist with providing lunch to the people installing the ramp.

To assist with either 1 or 2 there is no skill level needed. Part of what is involved is just moving boards or the basic use of a drill. Volunteering is open to anyone age 14 or above. Youth would need to come with a responsible adult.
