



#### **Medicare's Open Enrollment Notices**

Medicare's Open Enrollment runs from October 15 through December 7

During this time, you can make changes to your health insurance coverage, including adding or dropping different types of Medicare coverage. The last change you make will take effect on January 1, 2019.

Even if you are happy with your current health and drug coverage, Medicare's Open Enrollment is the time to review what you have, compare it with other options, and make sure that your current coverage still meets your needs for the coming year.

Sit with a SHIP Counselor to get unbiased assistance with reviewing your choices and answering any questions about any notices you receive. SHIP counselors can help you use the Medicare Plan Finder tool to review your options, pick a plan that meets your needs, and help you enroll.

#### Take action:

- Review any notices you receive from Medicare or your plan. Decide if you want to change your coverage. Contact your SHIP for assistance with reviewing your choices and understanding enrollment periods.
- Explore possible options for health and drug plans. Costs change each year, and you may find a less expensive plan that works for you.
- Contact your SMP if you suspect a plan has violated Medicare's marketing rules. Make sure you understand a plan's benefits before you enroll.
