Applications include requests for Seedling grants from the Cultivate Committee to help the groups get started. Perhaps invite a knowledgeable speaker for a Zoom conversation with all interested parties, or hold an online workshop about a particular skill that would help others learn more.

Once Seedlings have been established and take root, they may become Networks and can apply to the Synod's Inspire Committee for one of the appropriate Synod Grants. Some Seedlings may not take root or might last for just a season and that's OK.
