Drawing Details

Getting your "ticket" number for the drawings:

On Wednesday, August 5, all registrants will be emailed with their drawing "ticket" number.

- If you are entered into the Scholarship Drawing by membership: the number sent will be your Texas Parents Membership ID.
- If you are entered into the Scholarship Drawing by mail-in card: the number sent will be a random, auto-generated number.
- If you are entered into the More Good Stuff Drawing: the number sent for the Scholarship Drawing will also be used for this drawing. If you are only registered for the More Good Stuff Drawing, the number sent will be a random, auto generated number.

A few more details:

- Texas Parents staff will create tickets with each entrant's first name(s), last name initial, hometown and state and ticket number.
- There will be two separate populations of tickets, one for the Scholarship Drawing and another for the More Good Stuff Drawing.
- **You will need your number for the drawing!**
- Individual ticket numbers are distributed per household, not per person. Households can only win one time.
- Both drawings will be conducted during a pre-recorded video. All entrants will be emailed a link to the video on Friday, August 7 at 6 p.m. CDT
- Texas Parents staff will contact all winners afterwards with more information.
