- You can help us **feed food insecure children.** Protect Idaho Kids Foundation (PIK) is providing **free lunches and a day at Anne Morrison Park** during the summer months to offer these children and their families an escape from the Covid-19 lockdown. We will comply with social distancing and Covid-19 health practices.
- Each person with a ticket will be given a pre-packaged lunch consisting of a sandwich, fruit, chips and a milk or soft drink. Adults who bring kids will also be provided a free lunch, but they must have a ticket for each person. Lunches can be taken home or eaten at the park as long as local, state, and national Covid-19 restrictions are observed.
- The program will run for 10 weeks each Sunday 12noon – 2pm from June 28 to August 30th. Tickets will be free but required, providing an accurate count for the number of lunches needed.
