- Once again Protect Idaho Kids Foundation (PIK) is providing **FREE lunches and a day at Anne Morrison Park** during the summer months to offer children and their families an escape from the Covid-19 pandemic. **Please join us.** The program will run for 8 weeks **each Sunday 12noon – 2pm from July 11 to August 29th.**
- **LUNCHES ARE FREE.** Adults accompanying children will be served as well. Besides a free lunch for the whole family and a day at the park, we will hold a drawing for prizes each PIKnic day. Everyone attending the PIKnics will get a ticket for the drawing. The prizes will include a boy's and a girl's bicycle to be given away the last week of the PIKnics on August 29th. Bicycles will be provided by the Boise Bicycle Project.
- **Directions:** Enter on the West side of Ann Morrison Park off Americana Blvd. Head east towards the fountain. Our tables will be set up just off the roadway on the south side of Ann Morrison Fountain. See you there.
- All guests attending the PIKnics will be given a pre-packaged lunch consisting of a sandwich, fruit, chips, cookie, and a milk or soft drink. Lunches can be taken home or eaten at the park as long as local, state, and national Covid-19 restrictions are observed. A food pantry will also be provided, and guests are invited to take various food products with them to enjoy later in the week.
