Immanuel Lutheran Church (707 W. Fort Street, Boise, ID) is currently searching for a self-motivated Independent Contractor to join our team.

Job Purpose: Provide video production (live streamed and/or taped) of worship services; set up and monitor sound system for worship services; perform other duties as assigned.

General Information: This position will be paid on a contract basis and is not subject to withholding for federal/state income tax or payroll taxes including FICA taxes for Social Security and Medicare or federal/state unemployment insurance. Additionally, this position will not receive benefits such as paid holidays, paid leave, health/life insurance or liability insurance.

Salary: \$18 to \$25 per hour, for up to 10 hours per week of worship service video production.

Responsibilities:

Before Worship Service

- Pre-record parts of service as needed
- Set up sound and video equipment
- Test and correct audio/video system problems
- Review bulletin for overview of service
- Check with worship leader and pastor for schedule and any changes
- Determine filming sequences and camera movements

During Worship Service

- Provide a distraction-free service as it relates to audio and video production
- Videotape worship service
- Adjust sound levels as needed
- Follow worship leader's direction and musician's direction (for example, boosting monitor levels)
- Produce live streaming events and services when needed

After Worship Service

- Clean audio and video equipment and store properly
- Note any broken/faulty equipment and take it out of service
- Send in equipment for repairs as needed
- Use iMovie/Final Cut Pro or similar video editing tools to edit together weekly service
- Upload final video to YouTube and ILC Facebook page

Minimum Qualifications:

- Experience operating social media platforms and uploading/managing content
- Experience using video recording equipment and editing software
- Ability to meet weekly deadlines for final production
- Able to learn new media platforms
- Comfortable working in a religious environment
- Must be able to work Sundays and certain Church holidays (for example Christmas Eve/Day)
- Knowledge of liturgical worship is preferred.
- Must pass a background check before work begins.
