Transitions. We are marking several of them during the month of May. On Sunday **May 5th** we celebrate an adult baptism in our 8:30 worship and affirmation of baptism by two of our youth in the 10:45 worship. In both of these services, I will lay my hands on these children of God, praying for the gift of the Holy Spirit to be with them: *the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in God's presence, both now and forever.* As these three people take the next step in their journeys of faith, I hope you will be here with me to promise our support and pray for them as their church family.

On Sunday **May 19th** we mark the transition from high school to college for four of our youth, again pledging our support as they embark on new adventures as young adults. As we offer a blessing on these senior high students, we also pray for the Holy Spirit to guide them in their new ventures, wrapping them in a quilt made by our Immanuel quilters, as a reminder of God's presence with them wherever they go.

We transition into our summer worship schedule on Memorial Day weekend, Sunday **May 26**, with only one service at 9:30am in our *\*newly air conditioned\** Immanuel sanctuary. For three months we come together as one community of faith in worship and fellowship. Watch for opportunities to grow in faith through learning and education too on Sunday mornings. Whether you bike to church, or are dressed for a picnic or hike afterwards, summer is *Come as you are worship*.

The biggest transition we continue to mark in this season of Easter, is the transition from death to new life. The transition we celebrate in the Thanksgiving for Baptism at the start of our liturgy during these 50 days, in the waters where *death is washed away forever and we are clothed with God's mercy and forgiveness*.

In all of our transitions we give thanks for Immanuel, God with us, who frees and empowers us to live as God's people as we share God's gift of love with all.

Jan Gieselman and Shane Maskalik were elected at our January annual meeting to join Pastor Gretchen as Immanuel's voting delegates at the assembly. However because this spring's Assembly is at The Riverside Hotel in Boise, others are also invited to participate as visitors.

This year's theme is "Global Mission: We Walk Together" with guests from our companion synod, the Ulanga Kilombero Diocese of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tanzania. Additionally, our synod is partnering with the ELCA so that our Assembly will be a Global event, featuring guests to assist in worship leadership, provide plenary addresses that explore our theme, and meaningful workshops that will deepen our connection with the global church.

Name change! One of the orders of business at this year's Synod Assembly will be to choose what we will be called in the future. The Synod Council forwarded two names to the Assembly for consideration: Inland Northwest Synod and Intermountain Northwest Synod. Both names better represent all the congregations and ministries that are a part of us. We walk together!

## Build Us Up, Lord!


### **Build Us Up, Lord! ReJuv Project is officially complete**

The final accounting of ReJuv III is complete. Our wonderful contractor, Scott Hedrick Construction, is fully paid, the loan is finalized and the City of Boise certified our building for occupancy. In addition, our project was awarded two 2019 Building Owners and Managers Association/City of Boise Building Excellence Awards: Excellence in Safety and Excellence in Accessibility. Our sincere Thank You to all who made this project and the awards possible!

### **Project by the Numbers as of March 31, 2019**

We completed the project at \$1,349,522 which was just slightly under our final estimate of \$1,350,000. We had approval to borrow \$645,000 and due to our generous members and friends, our final loan balance is considerably less, at \$347,129. Through our **Build Us Up, Lord!** Capital Campaign we have received over \$1,086,037 to date, with \$170,834 in pledges still to be received and \$80,000 in reserve, enough to pay one year of loan payments. Our current gap is \$96,295 between funds given/pledged yet to be received and the final project cost. We have extended our capital campaign to a fourth year and we will continue to provide ongoing updates on our loan and capital campaign status.

Each week, our beautiful, renewed Sanctuary and Fellowship Hall continue to provide new experiences in worship, fellowship and service. As we look to the future, we are confident in God's love to continue to Build Us Up and show us ways to grow in faith and fulfill our purpose to "Share God's gift of love with all".

## Bringing Communion to the Homebound

## Job Openings at Immanuel



### HOSPITALITY HOST

**Job Purpose:** Set up drinks and treats, greet people, clean up, keep kitchen and supplies in order and maintain a safe and inviting reception space during Sunday morning coffee hour; facilitate wedding and funeral receptions.

**General Information:** Hours are from 9:00am to 12:15pm during the regular church season, and from 9am-11am during the summer. The host must utilize good handwashing and wear food service gloves when handling food. There is no responsibility for personally providing treats/food or soliciting for treats/food. This position may be shared by multiple people. The Immanuel Hospitality Policy and Procedures outlines detailed responsibilities.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Friendly and inviting personality, Effective communication skills, Organizational skills, Punctuality and dependability, Ability to assess inventory of needed supplies, Knowledge and use of safe food handling, Must pass a background check before work begins.

**Hours/Pay:** Approximately 2-3.25 hours per week each Sunday; On call for weddings and funerals. \$25 per Sunday during Jan/Feb/Mar/Apr/May/Sep/Oct/Nov/Dec; \$15 per Sunday Jun/Jul/Aug; \$75 per wedding/funeral.

### NURSERY ATTENDANT

**Job Purpose:** Provide a safe, secure, nurturing, clean and efficient care for children ages 0-4 during worship services; other duties as assigned to support the ministries of Immanuel Lutheran Church and the larger church.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Experience in the care of children 0-4 years of age with the ability to adapt and interact with a variety of personalities and characteristics, 18 years of age or older, Must present proof of current (within one year) immunizations., Must have current American Heart Association or American Red Cross CPR training/certification for infants and children or be willing to complete a CPR course at church's expense, Must pass a background check before work begins.

**A workshop to examine end of life issues and decision making as persons of faith**

Former Immanuel member and now Pastor Anne Palma from Our Savior Lutheran in Twin Falls and Penelope Smith from Trinity Lutheran in Nampa will present Estate Planning for the Heart, a program sponsored by our Eastern Washington Idaho Synod for end of life planning. The program will be Friday night June 14<sup>th</sup> from 6:30-9:00pm and continue on Saturday June 15<sup>th</sup> from 9:00am-2:30pm in Immanuel's Thomas Chapel. Topics will include how to initiate difficult conversations with your loved ones; medical care and treatment decisions at the end of life; medical advance directives (Living Wills, Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care, and Idaho Physician Orders for Scope of Treatment – POST form); clarification of values and priorities as end-of-life approaches; funeral planning; and how our Christian faith influences our living and our dying. Anne Palma is a retired hospice physician and Penelope Smith is a retired gerontological social worker. This is a wonderful opportunity to provide peace of mind for yourself and your loved ones, knowing you have made plans regarding end of life issues. ## Church Council Update

Les Gieselman-President, Barb Schmidt-Vice President, Renee Bergquist-Secretary, Richard Keplinger-Treasurer, Andrew White, Linda von Tagen, Jo Stensaas, Matt Christman and Pastor Gretchen Bingea.

The Council met Monday, April 8, 2019 at 5:30pm. Below is a recap of the meeting:

- The ReJuv project is complete and the ReJuv III Committee has completed its Mission. Council voted to dissolve the ReJuv III Committee.
- Pastoral Review Update postponed until May 13, 2019 meeting.
- Nursery Attendant position has been reposted on BSU Handshake; several local colleges were also contacted.
- Council approved the revised Hospitality Host position description and it is ready to repost.
- Barb Schmidt updated the Council on the Acoustic Alchemy Studio Brainstorming session on March 18, 2019. Ministry will continue for 6 months with regular scheduled formal planning meetings.
- Les Gieselman reported Northwest Elevator and Contracting Inc. will repair our elevator and take over on-going maintenance. ThyssenKrupp dissolved our existing contract with no penalty. The broken part (circuit board) has been ordered and is expected to be repaired this week. We received two gifts totaling \$12,800 dedicated to the elevator repair.
- Endowment Committee Selection is nearly complete.
- Council voted to elect the proposed Audit Committee Members - Lynnette Chandler, Chair; Chuck Anderson and Ron Dobson.
- Council voted to approve payment of invoice for portable microphones.
- Les Gieselman provided an update on the status of Linden House. The Linden House Committee has been inactive since 2018 due to a variety of reasons. Council agreed to have the Linden House Committee resume meeting regularly and move forward with researching options for Linden House. Les will be the Council Liaison.
- Council reviewed proposal for an Online Church Directory. Cost of the service is reasonable and Council agreed it would be helpful. We will continue to print a Directory. Les will have IT Subject Matter Experts evaluate security of Instant Church Directory Online and provide their feedback. Postponed decision until May meeting.
- Council voted to return the Immanuel Sanctuary artwork to the artist with a letter of thanks.
- Council discussed Safety Policies and whether we need to have an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) device on site. Barb will follow up with Boise Fire Department on response time and opinion.
- Next Council meeting is May 13, 2019, 5:30pm, Immanuel Library.
- Council members, certain Committee Chairs and staff members will participate in a Healthy Congregations Workshop led by Jim Grunow on April 27, 2019.


