Sr. Carmen de Barros Scholarship - applications due by April 11

The Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, Indiana are now accepting applications for the 2018-19 Sr. Carmen de Barros Scholarship. This is a \$750 scholarship for a Hispanic student who wishes to attend a Catholic high school.

Applicants must:

1. Be an 8th grade Hispanic student applying to a Catholic high school;
2. Must have a minimum average grade of "C" (or its equivalent);
3. Must submit a statement demonstrating financial need, if possible;
4. Must submit two recommendations - from a principal, teacher or youth leader;
5. Must submit a short explanation telling how they are living at list one of the Hispanic values.
6. Fill out the student application form.

The award can be received each year for a maximum of four years depending on the continued financial need of the student, a satisfactory academic performance commensurate with ability, and a satisfactory student conduct record.
