Welcome to Westlake Academy and the Westlake Academy House of Commons! The House of Commons (HOC) is the 501 (c)3 Parent/Teacher organization at Westlake Academy. We are looking forward to a GREAT new school year!

Unlike many PTO's, we do not charge a separate membership fee to join. Each parent at Westlake Academy is automatically a member of the HOC. However, we ask that each family make an annual contribution to support the efforts of the HOC. The HOC Annual Fee provides the funds necessary to cover annual operational expenses, including the HOC website, online store, Spirit shop, as well as HOC events and teacher appreciation. Due to the unusual circumstances of the 2020-2021 school year, the fee has been reduced to \$15 per family for the current school year. As a benefit of paying the Annual Fee, members receive full access to the online directory through Membership Toolkit.

As a member of the HOC, you can assist with fundraising projects, participate in educational and social programs, or volunteer your time to help show the teachers and staff at Westlake Academy that they are appreciated! Through our fundraising efforts, the HOC provides much needed support to the school to "fill in the gap" on needs that cannot be satisfied within the school budget - such as speakers, bleachers, senior bricks, smart boards, etc. We also host many teacher/staff appreciation events throughout the year which are supported by parents, which we believe is especially important during this school year!

We hope this packet will provide you with some valuable information to help you navigate the 2020-2021 school year. Committee Chairs/Coordinators

Room Parent Coordinator

Works as the liaison between room parents and the HOC, and helps support room parent activities at HOC events when needed.

New Family Mentor Coordinator

Assign new families to existing families throughout the year. Coordinate communications and answer questions that mentors or new families may have.

Spirit Night Chair

The Spirit Night Coordinator reaches out to local restaurants to find fundraising partners for HOC Spirit Nights. Once the coordinator locates a good partner, he/she works with restaurant management to determine an event date and the percent of sales the restaurant will donate back to the HOC. The coordinator also works with the Communications team to promote the event on Westlake Academy and HOC social media channels, weekly newsletters (the HOC weekly email and the Communique), and through grassroots efforts (bulletin boards and handing out flyers in car line).

MYP Ligison

Works as a liaison between HOC, MYP administration and MYP parents to help with communication and coordination of 2-3 "meet & greets" for the MYP community.

Uniform Resale Chair

Coordinates the collection, organization and resale of donated used school uniforms. Resale shops are scheduled a few times throughout the school year and special events. Supported by the Spirit Shop Director.

Mother and Son Event (Chair/Co-chairs)

Organizes the annual Mother and Son event during the fall semester. Typically includes Nerf war/dodgeball games, along with dinner & snacks. Supported by the Social Director.

Holiday Tree

Coordinates the setup and decorating of our holiday decor and trees throughout the school common areas during the month of December, along with taking down and packing away the decor after the holiday break. Supported by the Volunteer Director.

Kidz Rule the Skool

Coordinates with the school a day in May where kids are chosen to take over the teacher's and staff's place for the day. Includes the selling of tickets and implementation of the raffle, along with making t-shirts and providing breakfast for the children. Supported by the Fundraiser Director.

Daddy Daughter Dance Chair/Co-chairs

Organizes the annual Daddy Daughter Dance held in February. Typically includes coordination of a theme for decorating of the MPH, arranging dinner/dessert, creation and selling of tickets, corsages and boutineers for the girls and their dads or "significant others". Supported by the Social Director.

Bulletin Board

Decorates and maintains the bulletin board at the entrance of the PYP commons throughout the year to provide any important information for PYP parents and students.

As we kick off the new school year, we are working to update the online school Directory. If you have not yet received an email to update your information, we invite you to visit wahoc.membershiptoolkit.com to update your family info in your

Membership Toolkit Account. (If you have not previously set up your account, please follow the instructions below.)

During the update, you will also have the option to pay your annual HOC fee online. Paying the HOC fee will unlock full access to search the online directory. Please note that the HOC fee has been reduced to \$15 per family for the current school year.

Instructions for First Time Setup

Here's what you need to do:

- Go to wahoc.membershiptoolkit.com
- Click on the Register/Login button.
- Select "Create Account" and fill in the name, email, and password information. *Please use the email address on file with WA (where you received this message) to link to your existing family profile*
- Click "verify my email" and then check your email for a link to complete the process. The link expires in 2 hours. If you do not receive the email, check your spam or junk folders.
- Once you have verified your email address, log back in and finish the registration process.
- 1. Complete the Parent/Family and Student Information.
- 2. Complete the Directory/Publish Preferences.
- 3. Once these forms are complete, you will be presented with the option to pay the HOC fee.

Once the Primary Account is set up, the Primary User can "invite" other email addresses to access his/her account. This allows the Secondary User to have their own login information, but still have access to the family account.
