## Classes & Costs

ArtStream programs are designed for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDDs), including autism. Participants should be able to function in groups of up to 30 people with 1:4 staffing; independently meet self-care needs; follow directions; and demonstrate respectful, safe behavior at all times. Unless otherwise noted, ArtStream classes and performing companies are open to adults 18+. You do not need any acting experience to take a class or workshop.

ArtStream services are eligible for LISS and Respite funding. Students may pay in installments or receive full or partial scholarships.

We believe in theatre for an inclusive world and we don't want cost to prevent you from participating in an ArtStream activity. You may request tuition assistance for any ArtStream activity.
