**Beruchim Haba'im, Welcome to our beautiful Synagogue.**

**We hope that everyone will have a very joyous and meaningful Yom Tob.**

**A:** Kindly observe all the times listed in the schedule.

**B:** As this year the first night of Pesach is on Wednesday night, therefore all preparations for Shabbat - Hol Hamo'ed must be completed before Shabbat begins. **Erub Tabshilin** is also needed, details are described below.

For the second night Yom Tob, preparations for the meals can begin at the same time as for the Candle Lighting times for that night.

**C:** Stop working as early as possible. Get home early to welcome the Yom Tob properly.

**D:** Carefully inspect all leafy vegetables to be used for the Seder.

**E:** Remember to leave a fire on for the 2nd night of Pesach, Thursday Night - Shabbat Hol Hamo'ed and next Wednesday Night, which is the last night of Yom Tob for Candles & Cooking.

**F: Birkat Ha'ılanot, Blessing for the trees:** Location will be announced in the Synagogue

**G:** Remember to check the Kora'cha / Talet Bag for any Hames.

**H: Aliyot** will be sold on Pesach. Please make every effort to cooperate. We thank you in advance.

**I: Recite Shema** Times for Miami - Week of Pesach - After: 8:20 PM & Before: 9:40 AM

**J:** All weekday minyanim are followed by breakfast & classes.

## ERUB TABSHILIN:

### THE ERUB ALLOWS US TO COOK ON FRIDAY FOR SHABBAT.

NECESSARY ONLY FOR THE FIRST PART OF THE HOLIDAY.

**When a festival occurs on Thursday or Friday**, one should make an Erub Tabshilin on the day preceding the festival. That is, to take a matzah as well as a cooked food, such as hard-boiled egg, and place it together.

Then recite the following blessing:

**BARUCH ATAH ADO... ELO... MELECH HA'OLAM, ASHER KIDE'SHANU VE'MISVOTAV VE'SIVANU AL MISVAT ERUB.**

**Translation:** Blessed are YOU L-rd our G-d, King of the universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments and commanded us concerning the mitzvah of Erub.

After the blessing recite:

**BEDEN E'RUBA, YEHE SHA'RE LANA, LE'AFUYE UL'VASHULE UL'ATMUNE UL'ADLUKE SHARGA, UL'ME'EBAD KOL SAR'KANAH, MI'YOM TOB LE'SHABBAT.**

**Translation:** Through this Erub, may we be permitted to bake, cook, fry, insulate, kindle a flame, and do anything necessary on Yom Tob for the sake of the Shabbat.

(The Erub is to be eaten on Shabbat.)

## BERACHOT FOR CANDLE LIGHTING

**BARUCH...ASHER...LEHAD-LIK-NER SHEL YOM TOB** (For the first, second, seventh, and last night of Pesach)

**BARUCH...ASHER...LEHAD-LIK-NER SHEL SHABBAT** (For Shabbat Hol Hamo'ed)

**COUNT YOUR STARS!** Every Candle Lighting time has a star next to it please refer to this key.

- \* DO NOT LIGHT SHABBAT CANDLES **AFTER** SUNSET
- \*\* DO NOT LIGHT **BEFORE** THE TIME INDICATED
- \*\*\* LIGHT ONLY FROM A PRE-EXISTING FLAME
- \*\*\*\* IF LIGHTING AFTER SUNSET, LIGHT THE FIRE FROM A PRE-EXISTING FLAME

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL FLAMES ON YOM TOB MUST BE LIT FROM A PRE-EXISTING FLAME
