INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH SPOTLIGHT



Dr. Lisa Levin is a biological oceanographer. While her research spans a range of habitats, the majority of her work focuses on deep-sea ecosystems and how they are affected by anthropogenic impacts like climate change.

Lisa co-leads the international programs [Deep-Ocean Observing Strategy](#) and [DOSI](#), the Deep Ocean Stewardship Initiative. With leaders from over 15 different countries, DOSI integrates science, policy, and economics to advise on management of resources in the deep sea. Lisa is very interested in international policy, and has been an active participant at the UNFCCC COP climate meetings, the International Seabed Authority, and UN Biodiversity Beyond National Jurisdiction, along with many of her students.

Lisa and her students work with collaborators around the world to address environmental challenges. Jennifer Le is an interdisciplinary PIER student, studying how we can characterize ecosystem services in the deep sea for environmental assessment and monitoring. Soon, postdoc Oliver Ashford and master student Olivia Pereira will travel to Costa Rica, where the lab has been studying the spatial influence of methane seeps for almost a decade with the aid of submersible Alvin. Recent graduate Natalya Gallo and grad student Lillian McCormick both study the effects of low oxygen on deep-sea species.

In addition to their research, Natalya, Lillian, and Jennifer all participated in the [French-American Doctoral Exchange](#) program, where they toured oceanographic institutions throughout France, and met with French scientists and students to discuss collaborations and present on their current research. The members of the Levin Lab are ambassadors for deep-sea resources, ocean policy, and international collaboration. Check out more of their work [here](#).




