

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

The Schuylkill Deanery of the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania announces the 2025 Logan Memorial Scholarship Program. Under the Program, a maximum of three \$,1000 scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors who attend one of the eight churches within the Schuylkill Deanery. Consideration will be given to youth who participate in community partnerships with one of the eight deanery churches.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

Students applying for the Logan Scholarship must submit the following information: Letters of recommendation from their school counselor and their parish priest.

Essay of at least 250 words indicating their need as well as their long and short-term goals. Proof that they had maintained at least a 2.5 average or higher.

Copy of an acceptance letter from the college, university, or accredited vocational program they plan to attend.

Scholarship funds will be paid to the student in August 2026 for the student's first year. Applicants must have the endorsement of their Deanery representative attesting that they are a qualified fit for this scholarship program.

The application deadline is June 30, 2026
